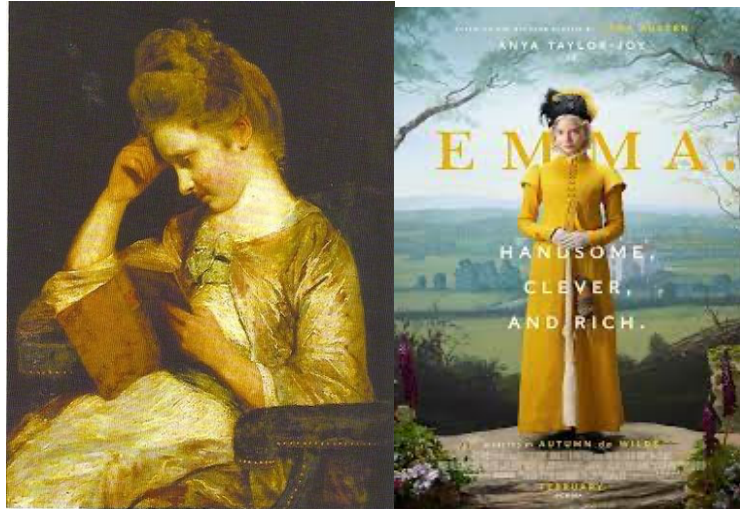


Welcome to ENG 328, "The Novel to Jane Austen"!

While you may use other editions of these texts if you already own them, if you do not already have these texts at hand I recommend renting, purchasing, or checking out these editions from the ASU library. I recommend these editions because they contain a few extra essays we will read for class, and because they are edited by contemporary scholars, meaning they contain useful footnotes (and in some cases, scholarly articles). These will also be the editions I will use in my lectures: having these editions will make it easier for you to follow the lectures and find the passages I quote from in lecture.
